WHAT DOES IT PROVIDE?

The Future Leaders programme provides:

- A vehicle for future leaders to grapple with the critical issues that the sector will face
- The opportunity to develop innovative business models through collaboration
- The skills required to lead sustainable business and to radically improve the sustainability of the built environment

The action-focussed programme runs across a nine-month period and is structured in four parts

1. Two-day residential programme
2. One-day concept development workshop
3. One-day storytelling workshop and project showcase to senior industry leaders
4. Leadership reflections event with the UK-GBC Leaders' Network

Key themes covered in the programme include:

- Personal leadership
- Sustainable innovation
- Business model development
- Storytelling
