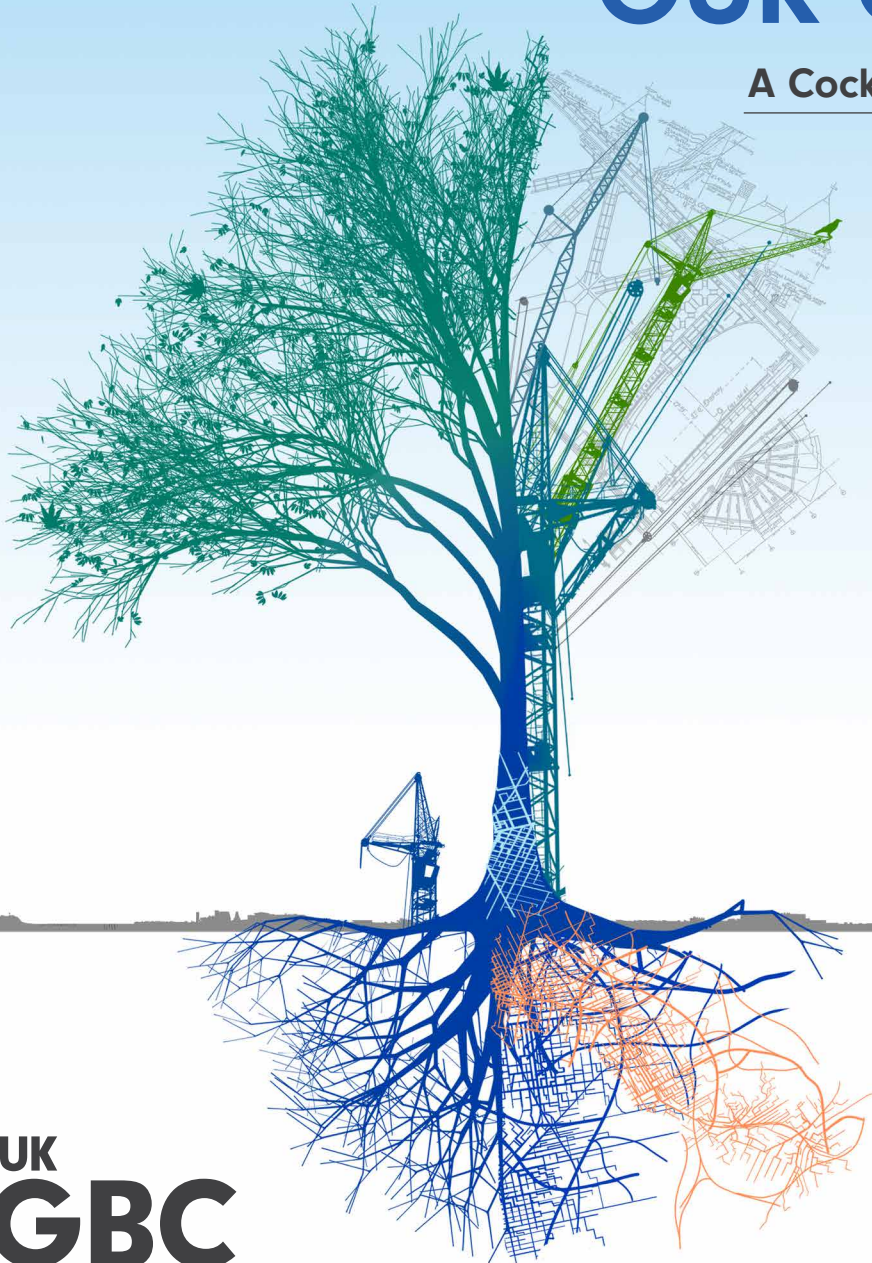


OUR CHANGING NATURE

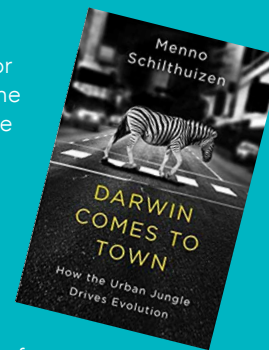
Format

OUR CHANGING NATURE will be held on January 31st 2019 as a late afternoon / early evening cocktail reception, featuring substantial hors d'oeuvres and canapés, music and entertainment. We aim to bring together 250 urban practitioners, built environment professionals and sustainability influencers for an extraordinary evening of inspiration and networking.

Central to the experience will be the venue. The Conduit is a newly opened London members' club for a diverse community of people passionate about social change. The building design has embraced biophilic principles, with a sourcing strategy prioritising the use of local and natural materials. This event is an opportunity for our guests to experience the building, and learn from the techniques used to bring nature and purpose central to the design process.

Renowned evolutionary biologist Professor Menno Schilthuizen, author of "Darwin Comes to Town" and "The Loom of Life" will deliver the keynote address. Professor Schilthuizen is a leading urban ecologist, studying how our manmade environments are accelerating and changing the evolution of the animals and plants around us.

Our guests, multi-disciplinary leaders from across the built environment sector, will have a unique opportunity to engage with Professor Schilthuizen in person.
